What is it?

Our School Development Module centres around a powerful custom form builder which can be used to create your SEF and SDP documents online and share them with the appropriate staff.

Both types of document can be created using the Ofsted categories, your school's own categories, or both. Evaluate where your school stands using judgement sections on your SEF, then pull that information through to your SDP, and from there list your school development priorities, assign actions to specific staff, make notes of resources required and more.

- Create documents at both school and subject/ year group level
- Year group and department heads can link their priorities back to main school priorities
- Assign actions to responsible staff which they can see when they log in
- RAG rate your school against descriptors to help identify what's going well and what isn't
- Download documents straight into Word for easy printing and sharing
